Until we see consistent outcomes over a full event, or events, we remain sceptical that AI materially changes the fundamentals."

"I don't like it, if I'm honest. Once you bring AI into scoring and handicap logic, you open the door to outcomes being shaped rather than simply recorded. Golf lives and dies on trust in the numbers, and if players start to believe that algorithms can nudge handicaps, validate some scores differently to others, or influence how results are interpreted, then the integrity of the competition is at risk. Until there is absolute transparency and proof that the system cannot be steered in any direction, people will inevitably question whether results are being fixed before the first tee shot is even struck."
